APPLICATION ANALYSIS

Based on the current taxable assessed valuation of the District, a 10.57 mills tax will generate an estimated \$690,300 annually.

The proposed proposition was last presented to the voters at the November 18, 2017, election for which it passed.

The proposition is considered a renewal tax.

The Notice of Election reflects the estimated cost of the election is \$2,600.

East Carroll Parish Hospital Service District, East Carroll Parish, Louisiana (the "District"), on Tuesday, November 3, 2026, to submit to the electors of the District the following proposition:

**PROPOSITION
(MILLAGE RENEWAL)**

Shall East Carroll Parish Hospital Service District, East Carroll Parish, Louisiana (the "District"), be authorized to continue to levy a special tax of 10.57 mills on all property subject to taxation within the District (an estimated \$690,300 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the tax for an entire year), for a period of 10 years, beginning with the year 2028 and ending with the year 2037, with the avails or proceeds of said tax to be used exclusively for the operation and maintenance of the East Carroll Parish Hospital?

As Set Forth By: * resolution adopted on May 28, 2026, by the Board of Commissioners of East Carroll Parish Hospital Service District, East Carroll Parish, Louisiana, acting as the governing authority of the District, and Police Jury resolution adopted on June 18, 2026

APPLICATION ANALYSIS

This 1% sales tax is expected to yield approximately \$15,000,000 annually.

This tax is a rededication of a 1% sales tax authorized at an election held on November 14, 2009, to be levied in perpetuity for salaries, benefits, training, insurance, administration, maintenance and other costs associated with establishing a paid fire department and for the acquisition of firefighting equipment, lands, buildings and machinery, and funding proceeds into bonds for making capital improvements for the listed purposes.

Pursuant to R.S. 47:338.54 Parishes and School Boards are authorized to levy 5% within the jurisdiction. The combined rate levied within the Parish, excluding the Law Enforcement District is currently 4.5% which includes the proposed tax.

Total sales tax within this jurisdiction is:

The Notice of Election reflects the estimated cost of the election is \$4,500.

Shall the Parish, on Tuesday, November 3, 2026 submit to the electors of the Parish the following proposition:

Proposition Language *

Shall the Parish of Plaquemines, State of Louisiana ("Parish") be authorized (i) to rededicate 30% of net revenues collected in the future from the levy and collection of an existing 1% sales and use tax (the "Tax") authorized to be levied in the Parish perpetually pursuant to an election held on November 14, 2009 (an estimated \$15,000,000 reasonably expected to be collected from the levy of the Tax for an entire year), to provide funding for Plaquemines Parish Emergency Medical Services, such funds to be used for the purposes of paying costs associated with the provision of emergency medical services in the Parish, including operations, salaries, training and the acquisition and/or construction of land, buildings, equipment, and machinery for such purposes, and (ii) to continue to use 70% net revenues of the Tax for paying salaries, benefits, training, insurance, administration, maintenance and other costs associated with establishing a paid fire department for the Parish, with said funds to be additionally dedicated for expenditure for the acquisition of firefighting equipment, lands, buildings and machinery as may be necessary to provide adequate fire protection?
