Based on the current taxable assessed valuation of the District, a 6.0 mills tax will generate an estimated \$71,000 annually.

The proposed proposition was last presented to the voters at the December 6, 2014, election for which it passed.

The proposition is considered a <u>renewal</u> tax.

The Notice of Election reflects the estimated cost of the election is \$21,500.


